

Suffolk Bat Group - Analoook training on 27th September 2019

The training is suitable for those with some experience in bat identification such as being able to recognise common species on a heterodyne detector. Analoook is software which analyses .zc files, typically produced by Titley Scientific products as well as some others.

The course includes

- how to download zc files from Anabat Express and Anabat SD2
- Data filing
- How to display sonograms
- Identification of typical sounds from most UK species

The course costs £50 per person which will be donated to Suffolk Bat Group funds.

Maximum 8 people.

You will need a Windows laptop and some advance preparation will be needed. This will be sent out after you have booked and paid.
