



TRIMLEY MARSHES WADER AND WILDFOWL SPECTACLES 2021



At high tide on the estuary, the reserve swells with waterfowl and waders seeking rest, preening or feeding opportunities, while the estuarine mudflats are covered. Birds flock to the floods and lagoons in large numbers up to an hour or two before high water. Particularly in winter months, it can be a wildlife spectacle to remember.
