NOTES

FORM OF PROXY

- 1. As a Member of the Charity, you are entitled to appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, speak and vote at a general meeting of the Charity. You can only appoint a proxy using the procedures set out in these notes. This form of proxy confers authority to demand or join in demanding a poll.
- 2. Appointment of a proxy does not preclude you from attending the Meeting and voting in person. If you have appointed a proxy and attend the Meeting in person or by teleconference, and vote, your proxy appointment will automatically be terminated.

APPOINTMENT

3. A proxy does not need to be a Member of the Charity but must attend the Meeting to represent you. If you wish to appoint a proxy other than the Chair of the Meeting, insert their full name on the dotted line. If you leave this space blank, the Chair of the Meeting will be appointed your proxy. Where you appoint as your proxy someone other than the Chair, you are responsible for ensuring that they attend the meeting and are aware of your voting intentions. If you wish your proxy to make any comments on your behalf, you will need to appoint someone other than the Chair and give them the relevant instructions directly.

VOTING DIRECTIONS

4. To direct your proxy how to vote on the resolutions, mark the appropriate box with an "X". If no voting indication is given, your proxy will vote or abstain from voting at his or her discretion. Your proxy will vote (or abstain from voting) as they think fit in relation to any other matter which is put before the Meeting, including a motion to adjourn.

RETURNING YOUR PROXY FORM

- 5. To appoint a proxy using this form, the form must be:
 - Completed and signed.
 - Sent or delivered to the Charity at: Suffolk Wildlife Trust, Brooke House, The Green, Ashbocking, Ipswich, Suffolk IP6 9JY.
 - Received by the Charity no later than 48 hours before the Meeting.
- 6. In the case of a Member, which is an incorporated organisation (e.g. a company), the proxy form must be executed under its common seal or signed on its behalf by an officer of the incorporated organisation or an attorney for the incorporated organisation.
- 7. Any power of attorney or any other authority under which this proxy form is signed (or a duly certified copy of such power or authority) must be included with the proxy form.
- 8. As an alternative to completing this hard-copy proxy form, you can appoint a proxy electronically by emailing the Membership Manager at membership Manager at membership number and postcode to authenticate your request. The simplest way to appoint a proxy electronically is to scan or photograph your completed form and send it as an attachment. For an electronic proxy appointment to be valid, your appointment must be received by the Charity no later than 48 hours before the Meeting.
- 9. If you submit more than one valid proxy appointment, the appointment received last before the latest time for the receipt of proxies will take precedence.
