Wilder Schools strives to embed outdoor learning into the curriculum, developing nature connectivity and taking action to improve school grounds for the benefit of wildlife and the school as a whole.



What do you get?

Year 1

- 9 days with an outdoor learning specialist working with your students in your school grounds
- Site visit for the class to one of our nature reserves

Year 2

- Termly meet ups with key contact at school
- Access to the Suffolk Team Wilder Schools Network and resources
- CPD day for teachers focused on outdoor learning (in year 1 or 2)
- Accredited training in Outdoor Learning to upskill your selected staff member (in year 1 or 2)

Year 3

- Termly meet ups & advice from your Suffolk Wildlife
 Trust Engagement Officer
- Continued access to the Suffolk Wilder Schools Network and resources

How much does it cost?

9 days with an outdoor learning specialist working with students in your school grounds

£250 per day funded by Suffolk Wildlife Trust

Termly meetings in following two years & access to a Wilder Schools network

£150 per session funded by Suffolk Wildlife Trust

One teacher trained in 'Level 2 Leader in Outdoor Learning' £380

Full day of CPD training for up to 12 staff £400

Visit to local nature reserve for one class of up to 30 children £165

Total cost to school £945

Please note other accredited training courses are <u>available</u>
Further costs will be incurred for more than twelve teachers on CPD training.

The school will be invoiced £945, to be paid by the start of the programme. Additional children on school trip and staff on training will be invoiced accordingly.

What we expect

from a Wilder School

- A key school contact for the duration of the project
- A desire to embed outdoor learning into the curriculum with a commitment to upskill staff to be able to deliver this
- A commitment to working in partnership with your Suffolk Wildlife Trust staff member to ensure the successful delivery of the project through community engagement and fundraising for the project
- Willingness to develop the biodiversity of the school ground with nature and students in mind
- An enthusiasm to empower children through their participation in the planning, and contribution to the progression, of the biodiversity within the school grounds
- For Heads and Senior Leaders to ensure information about the Wilder Schools project and its vision is disseminated to all staff


