## RE: Norfolk and Suffolk devolution and nature recovery

We are writing to you as a group of Council Leaders and Cabinet Members in Suffolk and Norfolk, together with Suffolk Wildlife Trust and Norfolk Wildlife Trust, to call on The Government to put nature recovery and net zero at the heart of the purpose and duties of the proposed Norfolk and Suffolk strategic mayoral authority.

It is our shared view that the establishment of A Mayoral Combined County Authority (MCCA) for Norfolk and Suffolk should maximise the benefits to local people, businesses, the economy, and the environment from nature-positive growth and development that support local and national ambitions and targets for nature recovery and net zero.

We urge The Government to implement the following measures to establish a MCCA for Norfolk and Suffolk that provides effective strategic leadership on nature recovery and climate action:<sup>1</sup>

- 1. Ring-fenced funding for action on climate change and nature recovery, including the implementation of the counties' emerging Local Nature Recovery Strategies.
- 2. Powers for the MCCA to secure meaningful contributions to nature recovery from major development, including Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects.
- 3. A duty to publish a coordinated action plan for meeting local targets to contribute to achieving The Government's commitments to nature recovery and net zero.
- 4. Adherence to the environmental principles enshrined in the Environment Act 2021.
- 5. Adoption of a 'nature in all policies' approach to improve the natural environment through the MCCA's functions.
- 6. Ensure nature has a voice in the MCCA through the responsibilities and representation of its members.

We believe these measures are essential to ensure a Norfolk and Suffolk MCCA can deliver meaningful improvements to the natural environment that would significantly enhance the health and economic wellbeing of the people who live and work in our two counties.
